Frankly, I've had enough of local crime

If I told you that in the past few years in Spelthorne, I have personally been the **victim of 4 serious crimes** would you be surprised? I didn't think so.

I grew up on a poor council estate in Hounslow in the 80s when it was a nice, leafy suburb. We all know what has happened to it now. I don't want to see **Sunbury & Ashford Common** go the same way.

In all this time, Conservatives on Surrey Council and the Conservative Police and Crime Commissioner have failed to **get a grip on crime** and it is affecting us here in Sunbury: we are seeing more anti-social behaviour, more thefts, more willful damage. crime - and that starts with improving education and social care (Surrey's responsibility) and housing (Spelthorne this time but also Conservative-run).

If elected, believe me when I say I am **absolutely determined** to use my seat on Surrey County Council to press for innovative and **progressive thinking** in all these areas.

We owe it to ourselves, our families, our friends, our neighbours and our community.

Plans for the old Fire Station are OK, but...

Surrey County Council have announced they are going to build some kind of **community hub** on the site of the old fire station in Sunbury.

Typically for Surrey, this was done **without local consultation** and the plans they have drawn up so far are somewhat vague. They seem to involve twelve units for supported independent living - an alternative to residential care - with live-in support.

They claim "Priority will be given to complementary services and/or activities with Spelthorne Council, and voluntary and community-based organisations." OK in principle but the **details are not defined.**

Let's face it, there are a number of questions that require answers for **Sunbury residents.**

Will the new building house the **adult education centre?**
What about much-needed **youth facilities?**
